# NAME, MOTTO, AND LOGO

As in every National Camp, we don't just build stories with great campfires and tents, but also with symbols and a spirit that unites us.

Why Jopará? What does this name really mean? How was the motto that will accompany us born? And most importantly... what secrets does its logo hold?

It's time to gradually reveal the meaning behind every detail and immerse ourselves in the essence of this camp that will challenge and transform us. Jopará (pronounced Yopará) is a word originating from Guaraní, meaning "mixture" or "fusion."

The word "Jopará" pays homage to the Guaraní language and culture, connecting with our local identity and highlighting the plurality of the Scout Movement.

Furthermore, it symbolizes the union of young people from different parts of the country, working together toward common goals and sharing fundamental values such as respect, fraternity, and service, underscoring the path traveled, the achievements reached, and the efforts of everyone who has contributed to forming a solid Scout community.

**PROTAGONISTS ONCE AGAIN:** The "ONCE AGAIN" reinforces the idea of continuity and legacy. We connect with those who came before us and those who will follow, showing that, thanks to Scouts, we will always have the opportunity to make a difference. # EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

- 1) Promote cultural exchange, creating spaces for the development of skills through understanding diversity.
- 2) Create a safe environment, cultivated by oneself, others, and nature.
- 3) Foster a spirit of service and social responsibility, as well as the meaning of a sustainable community.
- 4) Promote a sense of belonging to the Scout Movement and pride in its values for building a better world.
- 5) Encourage girls, boys, and young people to reflect on their role in promoting social equality.



## SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDGs)

**QUALITY EDUCATION** - Prioritizes inclusive and equitable quality education for all, promoting through this camp the continuous learning of values that will contribute to the full development of coexistence with others.

**HEALTH AND WELL-BEING** - Focuses on ensuring a healthy life and promoting well-being for all at all ages.

**REDUCED INEQUALITIES** - Seeks to reduce the gap between different social groups and promote social, economic, and political inclusion for all, creating a better world.

**SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COMMUNITIES** - Aims to build supportive and cohesive communities where everyone feels welcomed and valued, fostering care and preservation of the natural environment.

**RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION AND PRODUCTION** - Focuses on promoting good recycling practices and raising awareness about consumption. In this gathering, activities will center on this and how everything can have a new life through recycling.



# EXPLORE THE ROUTES

In the design of the National Jamboree, the routes have been chosen as a central structure to organize the activities.

The Routes represent the different key aspects of the integral development of Scout girls, boys, and young people, offering a variety of meaningful experiences.

These diversified trails ensure that each participant has the opportunity to grow, learn, and enjoy a unique and enriching experience.

## **ECOLOGICAL ROUTE:**

Promotes connection with nature and environmental awareness through conservation and exploration activities.



## **SPIRITUAL ROUTE:**

Provides a space for personal reflection, spiritual growth, and exploration of universal values.



## **ADVENTURE ROUTE:**

Challenges participants physically and mentally, promoting teamwork, resilience, and leadership.



## **SOCIAL ROUTE:**

Offers opportunities for the development of social skills, inclusion, and community building.



## **ARTISTIC ROUTE:**

Stimulates creativity and personal expression through activities such as music, theater, visual arts, and literature.

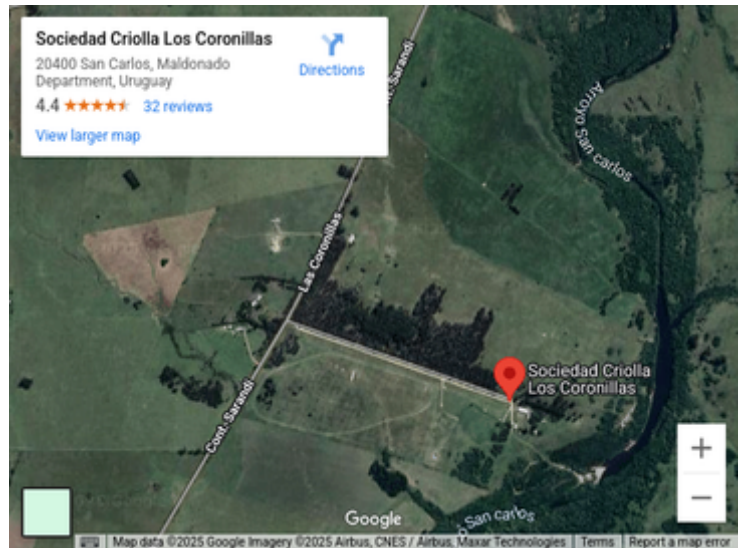
