26th July - 2nd August 2026

- Hike the whole Hadrian's Wall Path across England - Coast to Coast
- Meet Explorer Scouts from various Units and Countries
- Extra activities and evening events
- Back up support, baggage transfer and transport provided



VENIMUS VIDIMUS ET VICIMUS

26th July - travel to Penrith and meet up with other Explorers. Evening team building activities. Overnight in Scout Hut.

27th July - morning transfer by minibus to Bowness on Solway. Start Hadrian's Wall Path route into Carlisle and overnight at Ratlingate Scout Camp. 16 miles of easy low level footpaths.

28th July - hike Carlisle to Lanercost Priory. Minibus back to Ratlingate for second night. 14 miles, Wall starting to appear.

29th July - hike Lanercost Priory to Steel Ring - overnight at Winshields Farm DofE campsite. 13mile hilly route including the best parts of Hadrian's Wall.

30th July - hike Steel Ring to Chollerford. Minibus transfer to Dilston Scout camp. 14 miles, mostly moorland with less Wall

31st July - hike Chollerford to Heddon on the Wall. Minibus transfer to Dilston Scout Camp. 16 miles, mostly low level.

1st August - final day of hiking Heddon to Wallsend. 15 miles alongside River Tyne through Newcastle. Minibus transfer to West Hall campsite

2nd August - morning activities eg. canoeing/surfing* at South Shields activities. Afternoon travel home.

- Explorers to walk in international mixed patrols
- Remote supervised all week apart from Steel Ring and Newcastle Quayside sections (close supervised).
- Trackers used
- Explorers to cook or prepare all meals
- Back up minibus and trailer transport for kit.
