WHY A NATIONAL JAMBOREE?

It's been eight years since we last met and all in San Gregorio de Polanco, where we were able to be part of of the Tingó camp. Prior to this, we have held some national section camps. In addition, we had the January 2002 National Camp in Colonia del Sacramento. It's time to keep dreaming and planning more massive events where not only MSU Scouts can participate, but also more people from other organizations; even dreaming of international delegations. In 2024, the Scout Movement of Uruguay celebrates its 30th anniversary. 30 years of building stories, where we propose an educational project that prepare citizens for society; we bet on a world that can get better and better, as well as it's also time to keep showing society what we do. A camp is an instance of growth, learning, exchange. We want the educational proposal to be of quality, safe and attractive for everyone.



PURPOSE

Hold a National Jamboree in January 2025, with 2500 people, who can live the Scouting proposal in a different way, fulfilling with the educational guidelines that the MSU has. Celebrate 30 years of Scout Movement of Uruguay with an unforgettable celebration.



PLACE



Located in South America, Uruguay has coasts on the Atlantic Ocean. It borders Brazil in the north and northeast, Argentina in the west across the Uruguay River, the River Plate to the south and the Atlantic Ocean to the east. Uruguay has the International Airport of Carrasco (Ruta 101 Capitán Juan Antonio Artigas, Ciudad de la Costa, Department of Canelones).

Located in Maldonado, in the area of Sauce de Portezuelo, in front of Laguna del Sauce International Airport (Ruta Interbalnearia km 20.100), we can find a wooded green space with 120 hectares to enjoy all the activities that the camp can offer us. To the south, we find "Arroyo El Potrero", with calm water and suitable for bathing and enjoying activities there, in addition to having the coast in case of need.

DATES

Cubs: 6 days, from 22nd to 27th January, 2025.

Scouts, Explorers and Scout Network: 10 days, from 18th to 27th January, 2025.



WHO ARE PARTICIPATING?

The camp will be for all members of the Scout Movement of Uruguay, other Scout and Non-Scout Institutions of our country, as well as Scouts from abroad.



WHAT ARE WE DOING?

We will work for a program based on needs and interests of the participantes, in order to that they can live the adventure in this camp, have fun, get to know the culture of the place and have unforgettable experiences through games, tours, workshops and services, living the Scout Method and aiming for the Jamboree to be a safe and sustainable space.



REGISTRATIONS

There will be a pre-registration for all people interested in participating from 1st April, 2024. The final registration deadline for abroad Scouts will be on 3rd June, 2024.

COSTS

Scouts, Explorers and Scout Network U\$S 235.

International service team U\$S 100.

The cost of each participant includes accommodation, services such as water, electricity, bathrooms, assistance in case of emergencies and security, all food for abroad Scouts, complete program of activities and the participant's kit.
