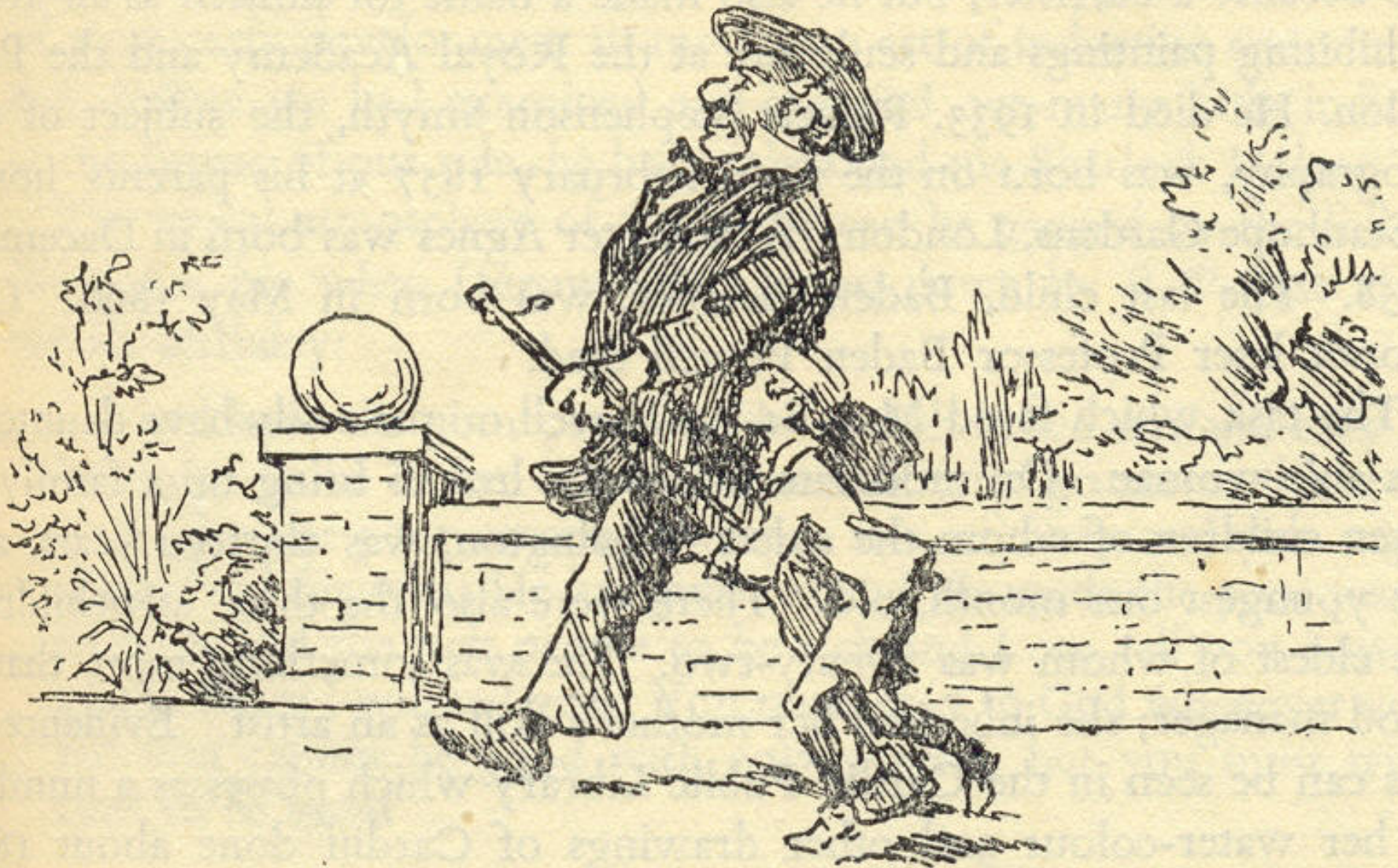

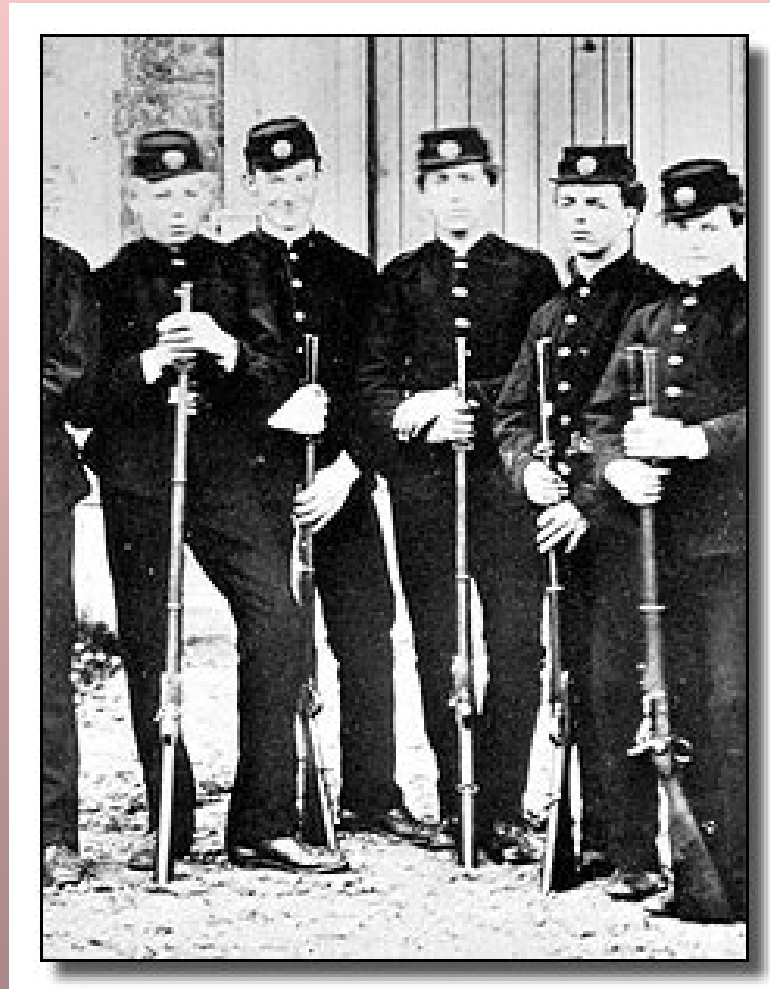

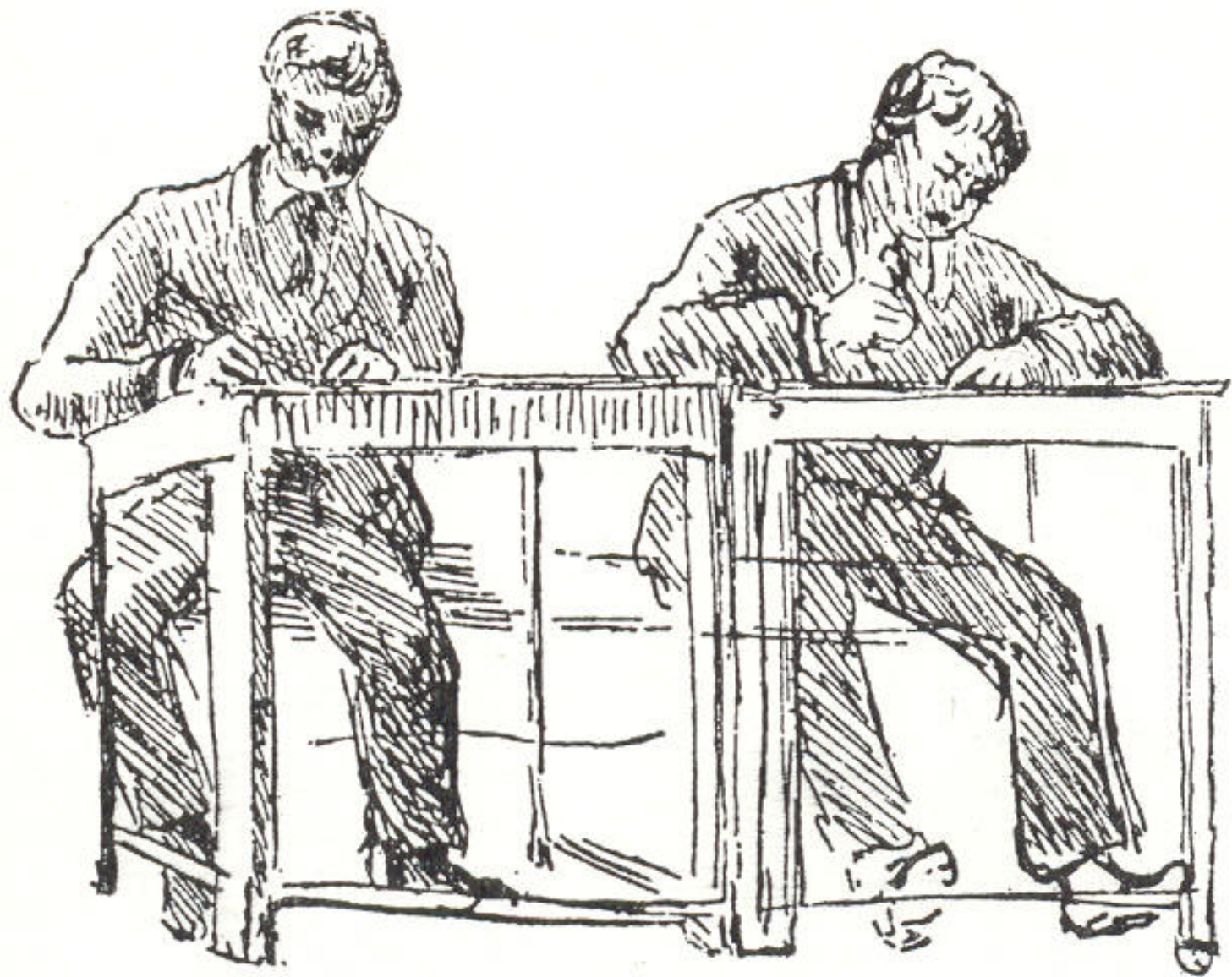

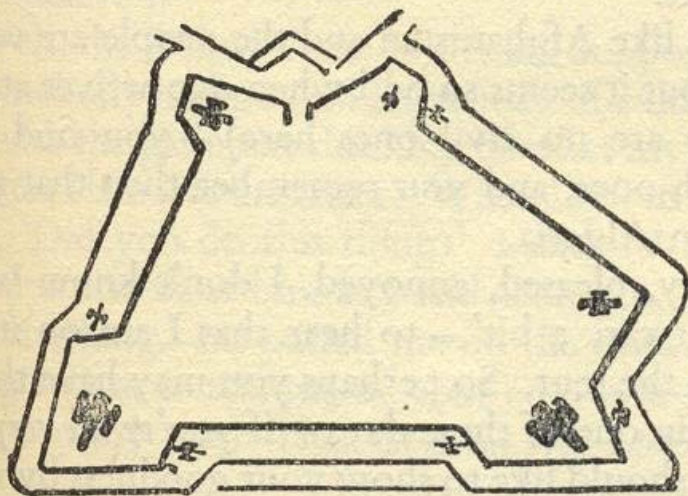
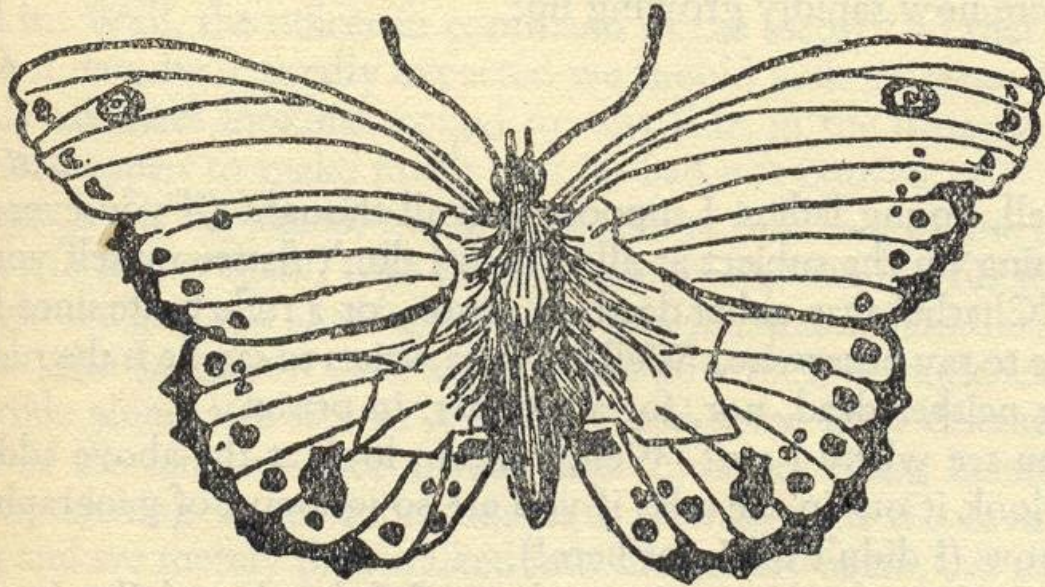

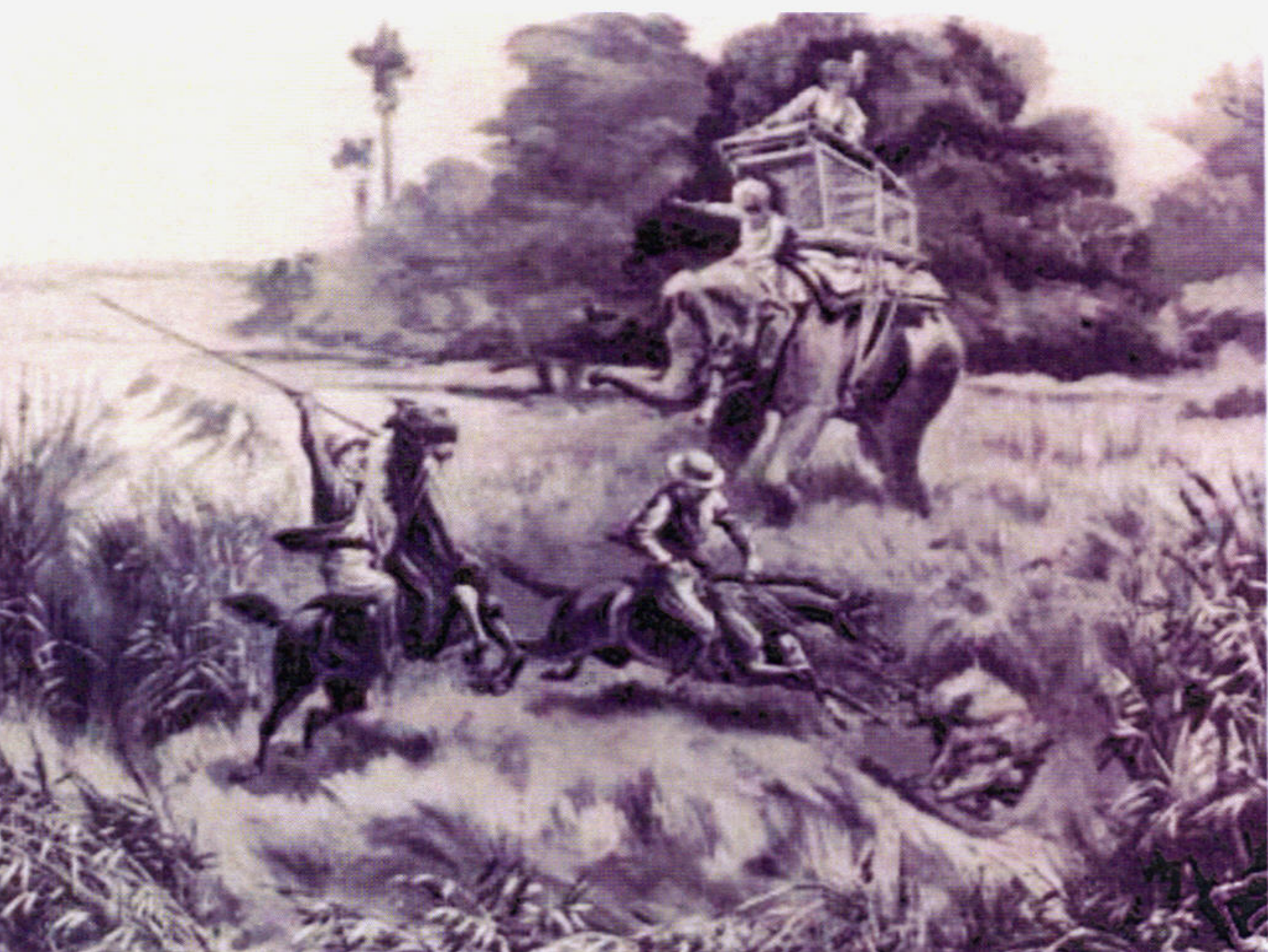

THE BUTTERFLY PLAN

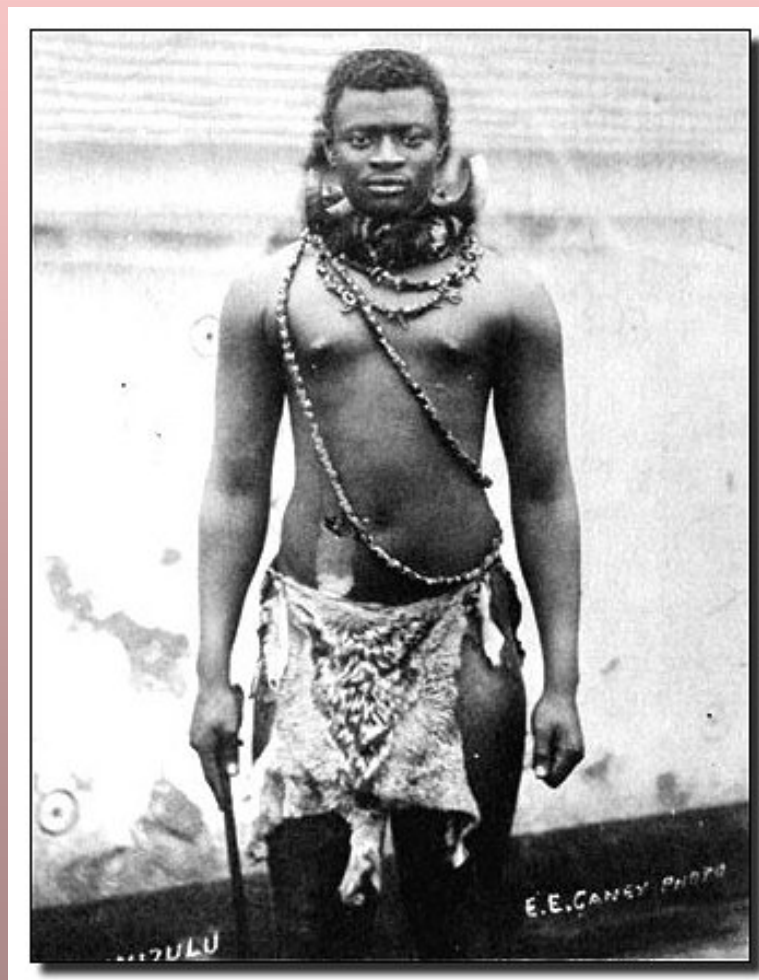
Only the markings *on* the lines of the butterfly have any significance



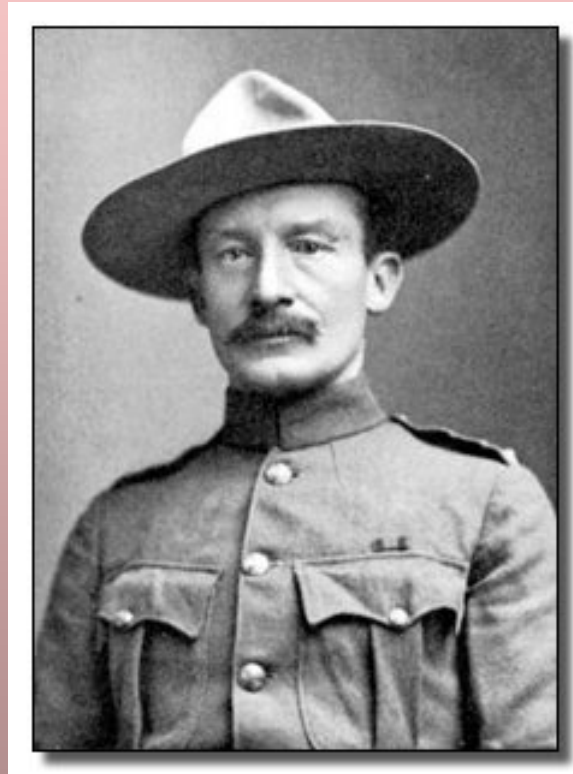

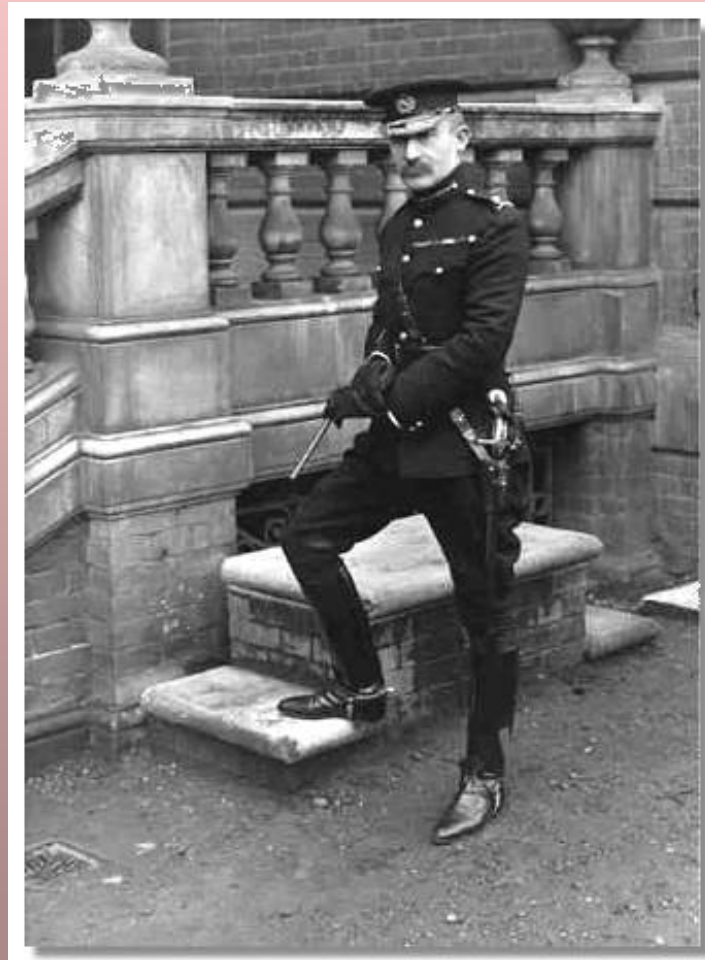

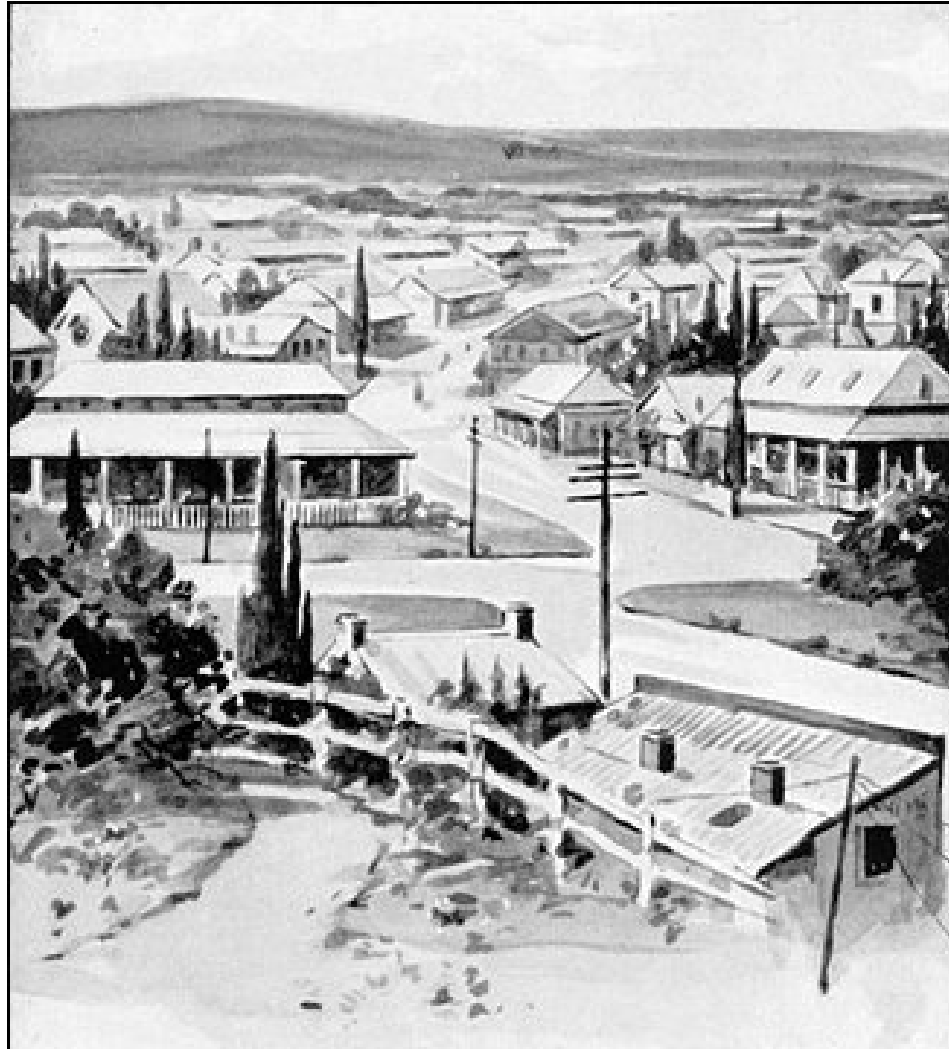

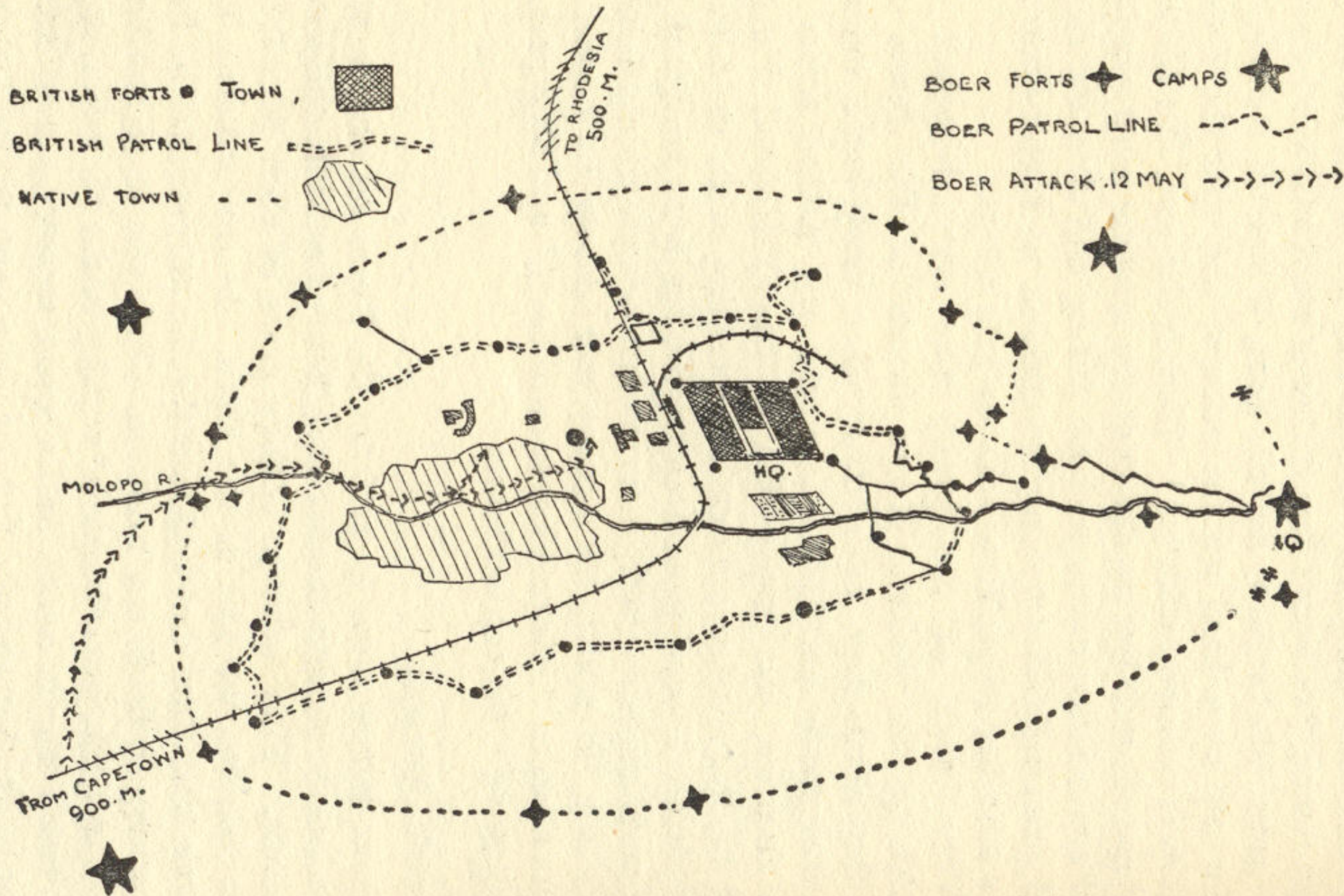

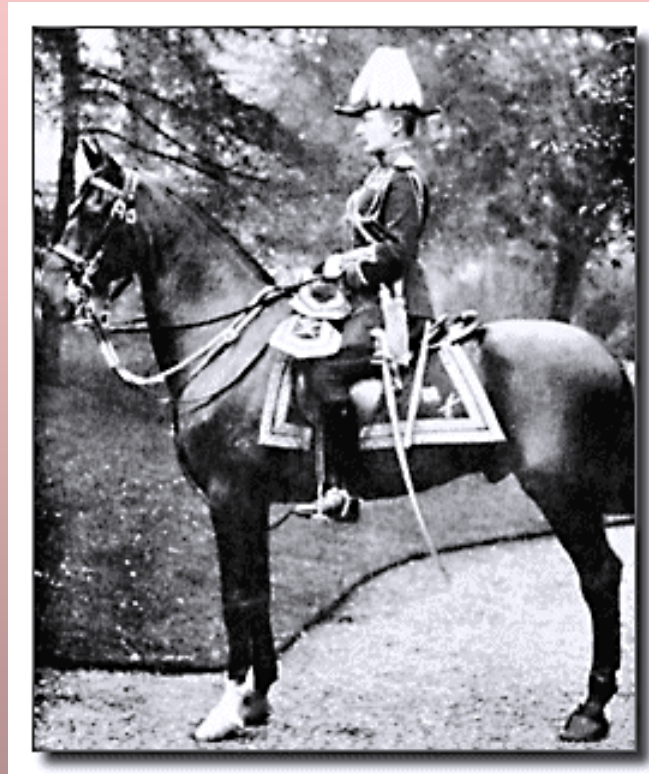

OBJECT — To help ^{existing organisations} in making the rising generation of native class or creed, into good citizens or useful colonists.

REASONS — The idea has been prompted by:

The want of attractiveness in some of the existing organisations for boys.

Numerous requests made to me for suggestions.

METHOD

^{carried out} — By giving, under the name of "Scouting", a novel and attractive form of training in many qualities.

~~This~~ ^{It} can be applied to any existing organisation or where such does not exist ~~a special one can be started~~ ^{it can without difficulty be run on its own lines.}

Applicable to town or country, at home or in a Colony.

Might also be extended to the training of girls.

Inexpensive, ~~and~~ easy, and interesting for the officers.

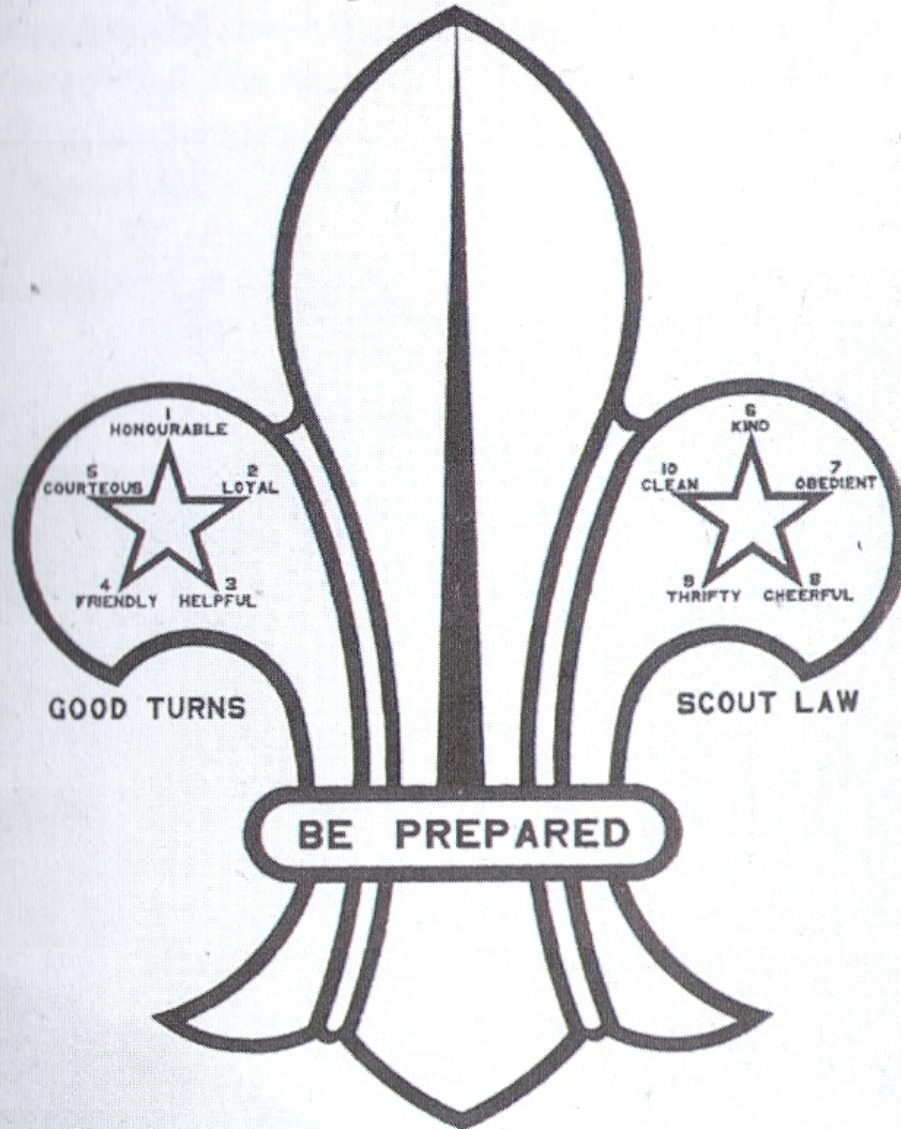
SUBJECTS

GAMES — For further practice and for maintaining interest in these a number of games and competitions have been devised, with custom "Honours" ^{attached to them}.

HANDBOOK — ^{inexpensive illustrated} A handbook, "Scouting for Boys", is being ^(giving all details of) drawn up, containing a progressive course of lessons which will enable an untrained instructor, though untrained himself, to teach his boys; — or it can be put in the hands of a boy for his own self-instruction. ^{Any profits from the sale of the book will be devoted to organisation of the Boy Patrols.}

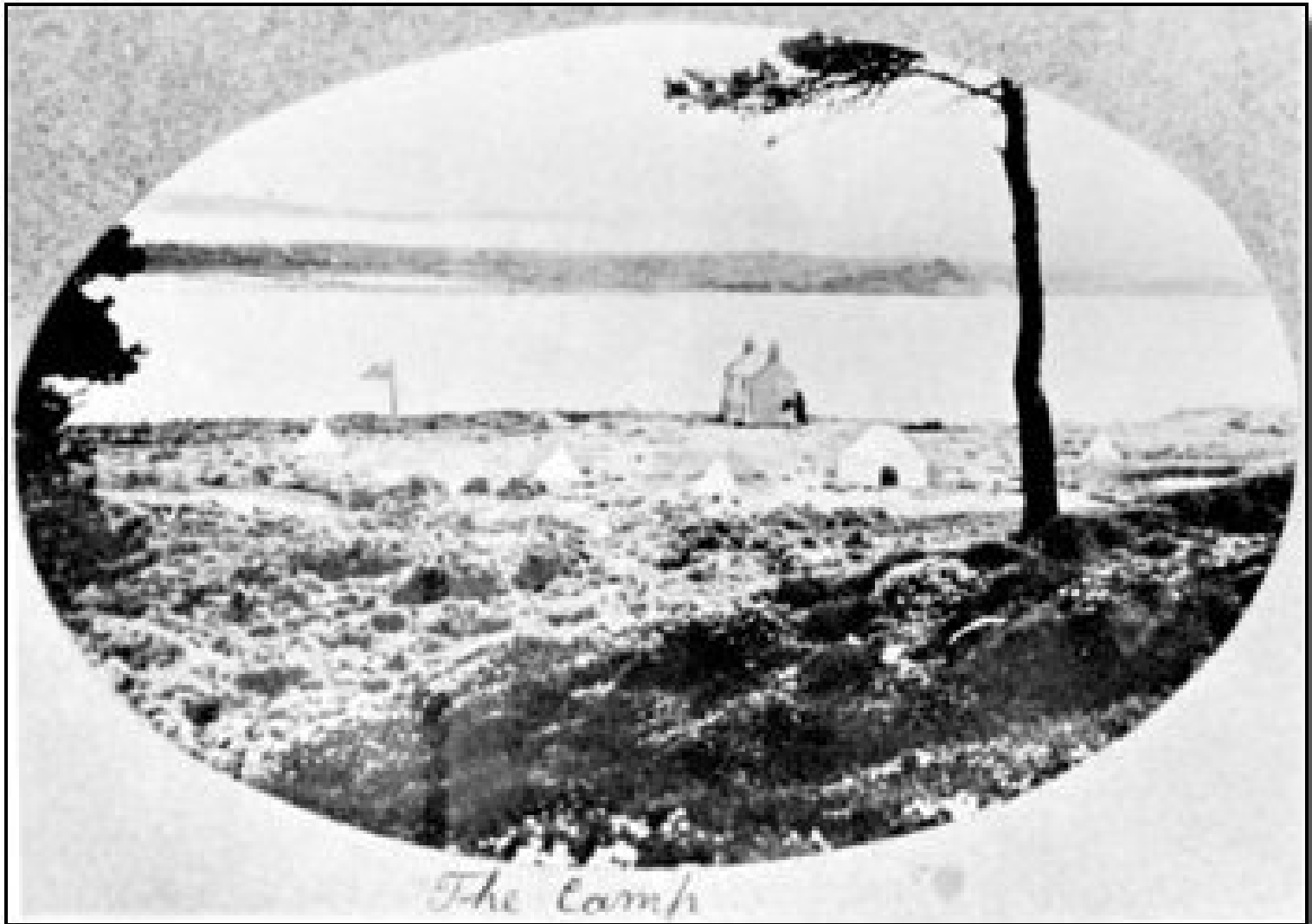

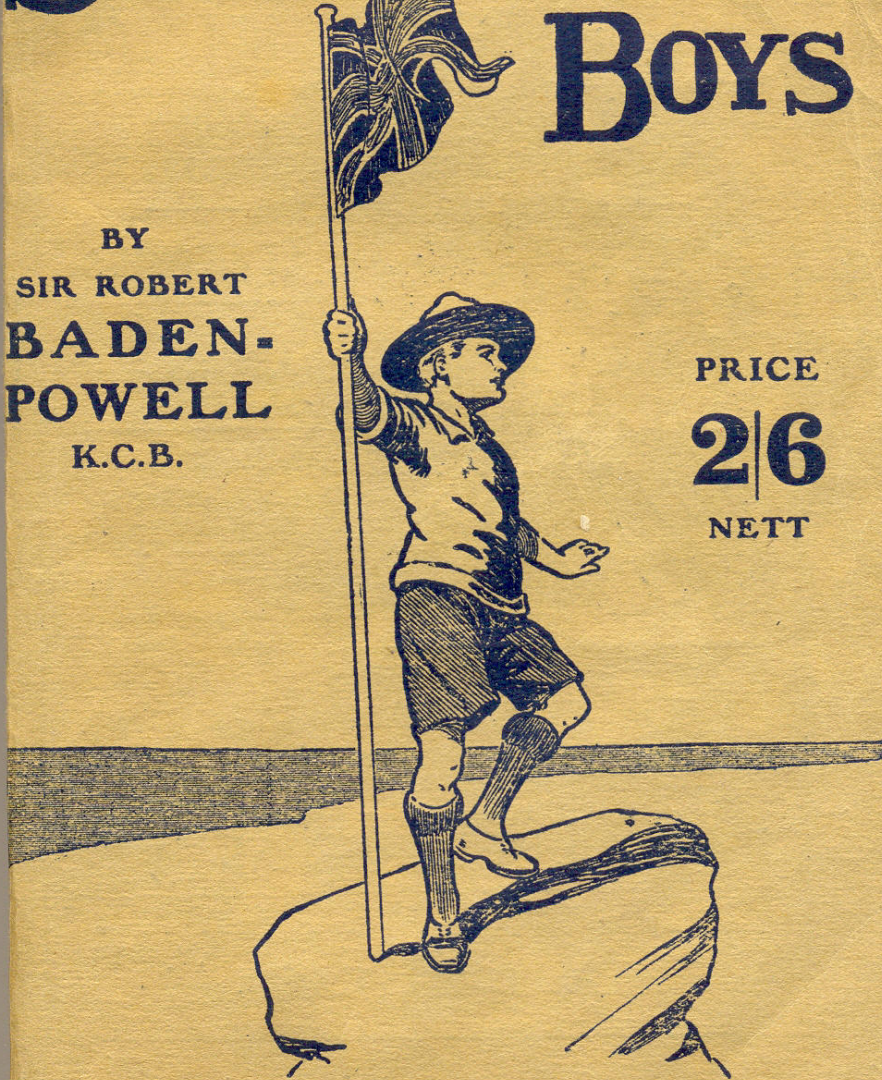
