4/5th of migrants in the world are hosted in developing countries. Less than 7% of the population living in the EU are foreigners (including EU citizens), only 4% are third countries nationals. On the other hand, Europe has rarely seen so many people in need of international protection coming to its borders, and must adapt itself and its structures in order to provide them with adequate reception conditions.
