1/3. 157 M in high-income countries, 77 M in middle-income countries, 9 M in low-income countries.



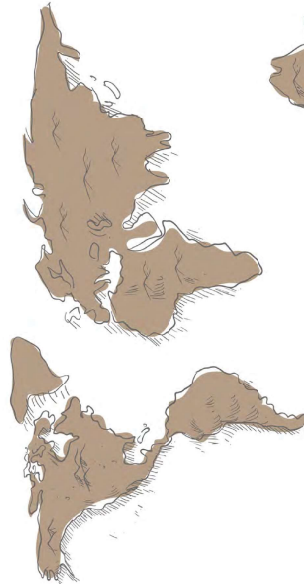
